CHILDHOOD TRAUMA TREATMENT PROGRAM

Reaching out to the community since 1979, the ADVOCATE CHILDHOOD TRAUMA TREATMENT PROGRAM provides a range of specialized services. Our mission statement is to provide and teach clinicians to deliver quality outpatient behavioral health care assessments, counseling, and psychotherapy for children, adolescents, and families that have experienced maltreatment, psychological trauma, sexual abuse, and sexual behavior problems.

Individuals can be referred to CTTP under our DCFS Post Adoption, Counseling/Sex Abuse, and SACY contracts. We offer contracts to private social service agencies and accept most HMO/PPO health insurance plans. CTTP IS NOT contracted with Medicaid.

Among the services provided by Advocate Childhood Trauma Treatment Program:

Psychotherapy and Counseling Services: *Our staff provides these services to treat a variety of behavioral and psychological conditions, including sexual abuse, attachment disorders, Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder, depression, anxiety, ADHD, maltreatment, trauma, child & adolescent sexual behavior problems, and other behavioral difficulties.*

Psychosexual (for children & teens with sexual behavior problems), Trauma, & MDSA Assessments: *We provide psychological testing utilizing specialized interviews and a variety of psychological instruments to determine the treatment planning needs, appropriate interventions, and effective follow-up care for children and teens that have experienced trauma and sexual behavior problems.*

Foster Parent Support: *Foster parents are included in our treatment and are offered support and behavioral management training to stabilize foster care placements of children.*

Community Education Presentations: *Our staff offers free educational presentations to the public and professional groups on child sexual abuse awareness and prevention and on other behavioral health topics.*
