## Masking Guidance and Accommodations Non Respiratory Virus Season

## ALL CLINICAL SETTINGS

- Masks will be optional for all teammates, patients and visitors in all clinical settings, with the following exceptions:
  - Symptomatic patients\* should continue to wear a mask when outside their patient room.
  - Areas where a respiratory viral outbreak/cluster is identified by Infection Prevention or Teammate Health.
  - In areas with long-standing masking requirements in place since the start of the COVID pandemic, such as emergency department waiting rooms, certain cancer care locations, pediatric hematology oncology clinic, inpatient hematology units, etc.

## **ACCOMODATIONS FOR PATIENTS**

- If a patient requests you wear a mask, it is expected that the teammates comply and wear a mask in any setting.
- Symptomatic patients who are unable to mask will not be required to mask.
  - Exceptions for patient masking will be made when the risk outweighs benefits and patient would experience harm if required to wear a mask, examples include health or behavioral health concerns such as but not limited to:
    - Sensory disorders
    - Communication barriers
    - Autism spectrum disorder
    - Anxiety disorders
    - Patients who are end of life
