

☐ 1) REGISTRATION AND TRIAGE SCREENING QUESTIONS:
Ask the patient the following questions:
Are you fully vaccinated*?
*At least two weeks after receiving final vaccine dose after 2 nd dose of Pfizer/Moderna or after single dose of Johnson & Johnson.
Yes -> Ask Screening Question #1
No -> Ask Screening Questions #1,2,3
1. Do you or any of your household members have any of the following symptoms:
a. Temperature: fever \geq 100.0F or \geq 37.8C
b. Respiratory Symptoms: New or worsening cough shortness of breath, difficulty breathing or sore throat
c. GI Symptoms: New onset nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
d. Miscellaneous: New onset chills, congestion, runny nose, muscle or body aches, fatigue, or loss of taste or smell
2. Have you or a household member had an exposure to someone that has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
3. Have you or a household member tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 10 days
If <u>Yes,</u> continue with Checklist. (If No, continue with standard triage process.)
□ 2) PLACE PATIENT IN ROOM
 For YES to above questions 1,2 or 3, and symptoms are clinically suspect for COVID-19
Implement Droplet/Contact
 COVID-19 Isolation Sign is placed on the closed door.
 Note: Negative Pressure (AIIR) Rooms are only required if patent is receiving aerosolizing generating procedures or is being ruled out for other
airborne disease (i.e., TB). For these situations, use COVID-19 Airborne and Contact Isolation Sign.
☐ 3) FOLLOW PPE GUIDELINE as outlined on the COVID-19 Isolation sign when caring for patient.
TESTING See Testing Guidance. Based on criteria, place the order for the test accordingly.
\square 5) LAB SPECIMEN
o 5a) Collect Specimen following Specimen Collection (available in the Information Center)
Personal Protective equipment (PPE) must be worn for specimen collection.
A nasopharyngeal (NP) specimen is considered non-aerosolizing.
Both universal transport media (UTM) and ESWABs can be used for specimen collection.
o 5b) Label each specimen with:
Required patient identification information
Specimen type
Date the sample was collected

o 5c) Send specimen to lab
6) LIMIT CAREGIVERS TO THE PATIENT'S ROOM: Limit caregivers to only necessary personnel and ensure all entering and exiting room, follow
appropriate PPE for each encounter.

11) DISCHARGE PATIENT when clinically indicated and provide patient with COVID-19 Patient Education found in toolkit or Krames patient education.
