COVID-19 Testing of Advocate Aurora Team Member Entering Congregate Living Facilities



As part of our commitment to the Advocate Aurora Health Safe Care Promise, we have added a new measure to enhance the protection of patients and team members in congregate living facilities.

Beginning 12/11/2020, the Advocate Aurora SafeCheck app, our technology-enabled symptom tracker, will be updated to also manage COVID-19 test results for our Post Acute Team Members working in Congregate Living Facilities, such as skilled nursing facilities (SNFs) and assisted living facilities (ALFs).

How It Works:

- Prior to entering, Advocate Aurora Health team members are tested per the congregate facility's requirements.
- Results are posted on the SafeCheck app on our team member's phone and to the Advocate Aurora Employee Health Department.
- Team members must show their results via the SafeCheck app on their phone prior to entering an Advocate Aurora Health facility or congregate living facility that requires testing.

Green: You'll see a green checkmark. Our team members are good to go and welcome to enter facilities today.

Red: You'll see a circle with a red X in the middle. This red signal means our team member won't be able to visit any locations today.

The SafeCheck app improves safety, as well as allows for greater efficiencies in screening team members before they enter sites of care.
