

COVID Cohort BPA Nursing – IL & WI

End Users Affected: Inpatient Nurses

The **COVID Cohort BPA** will display upon entering the chart for patients that has a documented negative COVID-19 test and has been in a double occupancy room for greater than 72 hours.

- The BPA advises the nurse to contact the attending provider to place a repeat COVID Testing Order.
- Select an **Acknowledge Reason**.
 - **Physician will order test** – this will suppress the alert for 2 hours until the provider enters the order. When the order is placed, the alert will not display again until another 72 hours of cohorting have passed.
 - **Snooze Alert for 2 hours** – this will suppress the alert for the user only and will display again until the order has been placed.
- Click **Accept**.

Critical (1)

Patient has documented negative COVID-19 test and has been in a double occupancy room for >72 hours.
Infection Prevention recommends these patients be **retested every 72 hours while being co-horted**.
