I. PURPOSE

To limit exposure of Health Science Students and to ensure appropriate training for Residents/Fellows to COVID-19.

II. <u>SCOPE</u>

This policy applies to all Advocate and Aurora Clinical Sites.

III. <u>DEFINITIONS/ABBREVIATIONS</u>

COVID-19: also known as Coronavirus Disease 2019

PPE: Personal Protective Equipment

Symptoms compatible with COVID-19: subjective or measured fever, cough, or difficulty breathing.

IV. POLICY

Health Science Students:

- Cannot be involved with clinical evaluation or treatment of patients with acute respiratory illness (with or without fever). Acute is defined as onset within the past 14 days.
- Cannot enter rooms where PPE is required, such as rooms housing patients in isolation

Residents and Fellows:

 When providing care to patients potentially infected with COVID-19 will be fully trained in treatment and infection control protocols and procedures adopted by Advocate Aurora Health; and,

- When providing care to patients will do so under the appropriate supervision for the clinical circumstance and the level of training of the resident/fellow.
 Faculty members are expected to have been trained in the treatment and infection control protocols and procedures of Advocate Aurora Health.
