# Childhood Trauma Treatment Program

## *Postdoctoral Fellowship Clinical Psychology Training*

*An APA accredited internship site*

This is a 40 hour per week postdoctoral fellowship training experience, totaling over 2,000 training hours over the course of one calendar year.

Fellows will receive a wide range of experience working in a Community Mental Health Care setting with children, adolescents, and families, some who have experienced trauma and maltreatment. Caseloads will have a balance of both trauma focused treatment, as well as general behavioral health concerns. The applicant should have an interest and past experience using Evidenced Based Practice, and an openness to learning.

Location: Hybrid model of treatment to increase patient access to services throughout the Chicagoland area. 2 days per week expected on site for patient care, supervision, and administrative functions.

Start Date: September 1, 2026; Training position is 52 weeks in duration.

Schedule: Postdoctoral fellows maintain a 40 hour per week schedule, providing 20 billable patient service hours per week. Postdoctoral fellows will receive 1 hour of individual supervision per week.

In addition to this, postdoctoral fellows may receive experience with supervisory responsibility, including maintaining supervision for a minimum of 1 CTPP Advanced Extern, as well as run a regularly scheduled didactic/group supervision with our training cohort. Postdoctoral fellows will also receive supervision for these responsibilities.

Postdoctoral fellows will also receive direct training and experience with the APA accredited internship program, including active involvement in the faculty meetings regarding programmatic updates, as well as provide support with administrative tasks and functions (i.e. coordination of the Stewards of Children workshops, community engagement).
