Childhood Trauma Treatment Program

Postdoctoral Fellowship Clinical Psychology Training

An APA accredited internship site

This is a 40 hour per week postdoctoral fellowship training experience, totaling over 2,000 training hours over the course of one calendar year.

Fellows will receive a wide range of experience working in a Community Mental Health Care setting with children, adolescents, and families, some who have experienced trauma and maltreatment.

Start Date: September 7, 2027; Training position is 52 weeks in duration.

Schedule: Fellows maintain a 40 hour per week schedule, accruing hours Monday through Saturday with six hours of direct patient service occurring after 6pm, or four hours of patient service on Saturday. Main responsibilities include:

- Provision of patient care: Our fellows typically provide 20 billable patient service hours per week. Caseloads will have a balance of both trauma focused treatment, as well as general behavioral health concerns. The applicant should have an interest and past experience using Evidenced Based Practice, and an openness to learning.
- Community engagement: Leading community initiatives and community engagement initiatives.
- Supervision of an Advanced Practicum Clinical Psychology student: This experience will afford the fellow with weekly supervision, under the supervision of a Licensed Clinical Psychologist. Our fellows receive additional supervision for this each week.
- Program faculty: Fellows will gain experience serving on faculty to focus on program-related topics for the CTTP APA Accredited Internship Program and CTTP Advanced Practicum Training Program.

Location: Hybrid model of treatment to increase patient access to services throughout the Chicagoland area. 3 days per week expected on site for patient care, supervision, and administrative functions.
