As we move through the spring—a season of growth and renewal—I want to share another important milestone in Advocate Health Care’s \$1 billion investment to transform health care on the South Side of Chicago.

Guided by the feedback you’ve shared through community listening sessions and ongoing conversations, we continue to expand care in ways that reflect what our neighbors said they need most: more access, closer to home.

I’m proud to share that our [Neighborhood Care](#) network is growing. These community-based sites offer convenient access to same-day, nonemergency services and help connect patients to additional care and resources. With four locations now open and two more set to open later this spring, the network will grow to six locations across the South Side. Here’s what’s new:


