### MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 24, 2019 GENERAL MEETING Dorothy Paige

At 12:00 p.m. Phil Dote, 1st Vice President, welcomed and thanked everyone for attending the meeting. Anna Lee Heisey-Pierson gave the invocation. A buffet lunch was served. At 12:40 p.m. Bob Hurdle, President, called the business meeting to order. He recognized the past presidents in attendance: Annette Goetz, Cheryl Kehl, Carol Lynch and Donna Wadycki.

Melissa Chumbley, Director of Development, gave a brief philantrophic update. Aurora Advocate Charitable Foundation has raised \$31.1 million toward its goal of \$38 million. Good Samaritan has raised \$1.475 million toward its \$1.5 million goal. The \$1.5 million goal was reached last week. A physician stepped up to offer a challenge grant of \$2 for every \$1 raised up to \$1 million to go towards oncology services. We have raised \$155,000 toward the \$500,000 goal. This is a great opportunity to triple the impact of a donation. The Festival Gala will be held on Saturday, October 12, with a Gatsby theme. There will be about 300 guests and we will raise \$1.1 million for the event. On August 2, we held Rally on the Rooftop, a regional fundraising event, which raised \$340,000. Thanks to everyone for your continuing support.


Patrick Barnes, Administrator of Support Operations, provided the hospital update. We are year one into the merger and have restructured into regions. We will be in a state of flux for a period of time. We have a new executive team with Nancy Tinsley as president. Patrick announced his retirement in December. The focus for 2020 is growth. We will be looking at neurosurgery and behavioral health. The budget is complete. The increasing revenue from the Gingham Tree and the Daisy Basket, which goes back into the hospital, is really great. We finished the Heart Walk in support of the American Heart Association. We are still focused on having a community presence.

Dorothy Paige presented the Secretary's report. The minutes of the May 29, 2019 General Meeting were printed in the September/October 2019 issue of the Auxiliary Hi-Lites newsletter. There were no changes from the floor. Dorothy moved to approve the minutes as printed, Gail Brown seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Donna Wadycki, Assistant Treasurer, presented the Treasurer's report. As of August 31, the checking account receipts were \$36,478.16, disbursements were \$25,409.30 and the checking account balance was \$21,333.85. We paid \$5,334 for a security camera for the Gingham Tree and \$25,000 for the Festival Gala. The money market balance is \$77,000.

- Be a member of the Auxiliary in good standing (dues paid)

- Nominees for President and 1st Vice President must have served on the Auxiliary Board at least one year
- Nominees for the Nominating Committee may not have served on a prior nominating committee until four years have passed since prior service

There were no announcements from the floor. There being no further business, Bob adjourned the meeting at 12:55 p.m.

Following the business meeting, Phil introduced our very own Ed Ptacek as our guest speaker. Ed presented some of the interesting cases he was involved in at the Cook County Public Defenders office where he worked for over 35 years. Phil stated that the next meeting will be held on Thursday, November 21 and our entertainment will be the Downers Grove North Chamber Choir. The Annual Meeting and Installation will be held on Wednesday, January 8, 2020 at 11:30 a.m.


