

Advocate Lutheran General Hospital Inpatient Rehabilitation Fact Sheet 2023 Diagnosis: Spinal Cord Injury

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Our program typically treats patients with spinal cord injury resulting from:

- * Trauma
- * Tumor
- * Stroke
- * Infection

Total number of patients with a spinal cord injury treated in 2023: 60

Average age of patients with a spinal cord injury treated in 2023: 66.6 years

Average length of stay for patients with spinal cord injury treated on our Rehab Unit in 2023: 16.0 days

Our program offers:

- * Peer visitors
- * Support groups
- * Adaptive recreational activities

Program facts

- * 85.0% of our patients who have had a spinal cord injury in 2023, returned home once they have achieved their established goals.
- * 8.3% of our patients who have had a spinal cord injury in 2023, went to a skilled nursing facility.
- * Our rehab team has the skills and capabilities of treating patients following a spinal cord injury as we serve more disabled and medically complex patients than those served in other facilities in the region and nation.
- * It is not uncommon for some patients to need additional medical attention and our physician can transfer patients to a medical floor in the hospital, if needed. 6.7% of our patients with spinal cord injuries transferred to a medical floor in 2023.
