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Our Program typically treats patients with amputation resulting from:

- Trauma
- Infection
- Poor Circulation
- Cancer

Total number of patients with an amputation treated in 2025: 16

Average age of patients with an amputation treated in 2025: 67 Years

Average length of stay for patients with an amputation treated on our Rehab Unit in 2025: 12 Days

Our program offers:

- Peer visitors
- Adaptive recreational activities
- Resources and support for adjustment to limb loss and improving body image

Program facts

- **56%** of patients with amputation returned home after reaching their rehab goals.
- **44%** required transfer to a medical floor for additional care.
- Advocate Lutheran General Hospital's rehabilitation program surpasses regional and national averages in patient independence and mobility gains for individuals with amputations in 2024.
- Our rehabilitation team possesses advanced expertise in treating patients following amputation, serving a higher proportion of disabled and medically complex individuals compared to other facilities in the region and nationwide.
