Diagnosis: Brain Injury

Our program typically treats patients with a brain injury resulting from:

- Trauma
- Infection
- Cancer/Tumor
- Brain hemorrhage (Bleed)

Total number of patients with a brain injury treated in 2025: 233

Average age of patients with a brain injury treated in 2025: 71 Years old

Average length of stay for patients with a brain injury treated on our Rehab Unit in 2025: 13 Days

Our program offers:

- A support group
- Emotional support and counseling for the patient and family

Program facts

- 79% of patients with brain injuries in 2025 were discharged home after achieving their rehabilitation goals—reflecting outcomes that meet or exceed regional and national benchmarks.
- 6% of brain injury patients required ongoing care and were discharged to skilled nursing facilities.
- Transfers to medical units are arranged as needed for planned or emergency treatments; in 2025, 15% of brain injury patients were transferred for further medical care.
- Our rehabilitation team specializes in caring for patients with greater disability and medical complexity than those typically served in other facilities, both regionally and nationally.
