Neurological Problem

Our program typically treats patients with neurologic conditions such as:

- Parkinson's Disease
- Multiple Sclerosis
- Neuropathy

Total number of patients treated with a neurological condition in 2025: 109

Average age of patients with a neurological condition treated in 2025: 68 Years old

Average length of stay for patients with a neurological condition treated on our Rehab Unit in 2025: 14.5 Days

Our program offers:

- Support groups
- Education and resources to promote lifestyle behaviors that promote wellness and longevity

Program facts

- 77% of patients with a neurological diagnosis in 2025 were discharged home after achieving their rehabilitation goals—reflecting outcomes above regional and national averages.
- 9% of neurological patients required ongoing care and were discharged to skilled nursing facilities.
- Transfers to medical units are arranged as needed for planned or emergency treatments; in 2025, 14% of neurological patients were transferred for further medical care.
- Our rehabilitation team specializes in caring for patients with greater disability and medical complexity than those typically served in other facilities, both regionally and nationally.
