Total number of patients treated: 870

Most Frequent diagnoses:

- 272 Strokes
- 233 Brain Injuries
- 109 Neurological Conditions (Parkinson's Disease, Multiple Sclerosis, Neuropathy)
- 81 Miscellaneous Conditions
- 46 Spinal Cord Injuries
- 44 Cardiac Conditions
- 42 Orthopedic Conditions (Back surgery, Neck/Back pain, Hip/Knee Replacement, Fracture)
- 27 Major Multiple Trauma
- 16 Amputations

- The average length of stay: 14 days
- The average age of patients: 71
- 78.4% of patients are discharged home after meeting their goals—well above the national average of 76.8%.
- Transfers to medical units occur as needed for planned or emergency treatments.
- The Advocate Lutheran General Hospital rehabilitation program achieves above-average improvements in patient mobility, self-care, and communication skills.
- We care for patients with greater disability and medical complexity than regional and national averages.
