

Advocate Lutheran General Hospital Inpatient Rehabilitation Fact Sheet 2025 Diagnosis: Stroke

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Our program typically treats patients with the following types of Strokes:

- Ischemic (blood vessel that supplies blood to the brain is blocked by a blood clot)
- Transient Ischemic Attack (blood vessel in the brain becomes weak and bursts open)
- Hemorrhagic (mini strokes)

Total number of patients with a stroke treated in 2025: 272

Average age of patients with a stroke treated in 2025: 73 years old

Average length of stay for patients with a stroke treated on our Rehab Unit in 2025: 15 days

Our program offers:

- Peer Visitors
- Support Groups

Program facts

- 82% of patients with a stroke diagnosis in 2025 were discharged home after achieving their rehabilitation goals—demonstrating outcomes above regional and national averages.
- 7% of stroke patients required ongoing care and were discharged to skilled nursing facilities.
- Transfers to medical units are arranged as needed for planned or emergency treatments; in 2025, 11% of stroke patients were transferred for further medical care.
- Our rehabilitation team specializes in caring for patients with greater disability and medical complexity than those typically served in other facilities, both regionally and nationally.
