Code Green	UTILITY FAILURE	For power failure ensure all essential equipment is plugged into Red outlets. Other failures, follow directions per policy.
Code Purple	EVACUATION	Await further directions. If emergent, evacuate Horizontal or Vertical.
Code Orange	EXTERNAL HAZARDOUS MATERIALS	Decontamination Team responds to the Emergency Department.
Code Black	TORNADO WARNING	Close all corridor, fire/smoke doors. Clinical areas move patients to corridors. Ambulatory patients/visitors to corridors or interior room.
Tornado Watch	TORNADO WATCH	Think of actions to be taken/precautions if a Code Black Tornado Warning is announced.  PCC's to print current Census in their departments.
Code Zodiac	BOMB THREAT	If receive Bomb Threat, call 83-5555. Quick search of area for suspicious objects.
Code Triage	MASS CASULATY	Designated departments respond to ED or labor pool as directed by policy
Code MTP	MASS TRANSFUSION PROTOCOL	Designated departments respond to announced department.
Code Trauma Level 1	LEVEL 1 TRAUMA PATIENT	Designated departments respond to announced ED room.
